How to Install a Replacement Cover/Pad on a Fixed Position Board

Note: Before removing your existing cover and pad, examine how it is installed since this will be helpful when installing your replacement cover and pad.

- Remove Old Cover/Pad: With board in upright position, cut strings on both sides of board. Then lower board to ironing position and remove old cover and pad.
- Place New Cover/Pad: Place the new pad on board, extending the edges slightly over the tapered end of board. Place the new cover on top of the pad and extend the edges approximately 11/2" over pad.
- Partially Tighten: Placing your hand on the tip of the board, pull one drawstring at a time to partially secure cover/pad over the tip of the board.
- 42-Inch Only: If you have a 42" board, fold approximately 6" of the excess cover underneath the pad.

Thread Drawstrings: With board in upright position, thread the ends of the drawstring starting from the inside of the cover. Pull through each eyelet according to board size.

42" Boards: Use middle eyelets 46" Boards: Use bottom eyelets

- Finish Threading: Thread drawstrings through the eyelets found on the outside edges of cover.
- Finish Tightening & Tie Strings: While firmly holding your hand over the end of the board, keeping the cover/pad in one place, fully tighten one drawstring at a time, pulling snug. Caution: Pull slowly, being careful not to snap string.

Tie tightened string into a knot, then cut excess string from each side.

How to Install a Replacement Cover/Pad on a Swivel Board

Note: Before removing your existing cover and pad, examine how it is installed since this will be helpful when installing your replacement cover and pad.

- Remove Old Cover/Pad: Lower the board and swivel it parallel to the wall. Cut strings on both sides of cover, and remove old cover/pad.
- Place New Cover/Pad: Place the new pad on board, extending the edges slightly over the tapered end of board. Place the new cover on top of the pad and extend the edges approximately 11/2" over new pad.
- Partially Tighten: Placing your hand on the tip of the board, pull one drawstring at a time to partially secure cover/pad over the tip of the board.
- 42-Inch Only: If you have a 42" board, fold approximately 6" of the excess cover underneath the pad.

Thread Drawstrings: Thread the ends of the drawstrings through the eyelets based on board size:

42" Boards: Use middle eyelets 46" Boards: Use bottom eyelets

- Finish Threading: Thread drawstrings through the eyelets found on the outside edges of cover.
- Finish Tightening & Tie Strings: While firmly holding your hand over the end of the board, keeping the cover/pad in one place, fully tighten one drawstring at a time, pulling snug. Caution: Pull slowly, being careful not to snap string.

Tie tightened string into a knot, then cut excess string from each side.
