
Category J gaskets for use with listed steel frames and/or classi- fied steel covered composite, hollow metal doors rated up to and including 3 hours; wood and plastic covered composite doors rated up to and including 1-1/2 hours; and wood core doors rated for 20 minutes. (Thresholds may or may not contain gasketing material).

Installation Instructions:

Top (plan) view of door opening (out-swing type)



- 1. Measure width of door opening from jamb to jamb and stop to stop and mark ends of threshold for trimming.
- 2. Trim ends of threshold to fit around door jambs and stops. Position flat (or top) portion of threshold directly under door. Lower slope should point to the exterior.
- 3. Drill pilot holes in floor through pre-drilled holes in threshold.
- 4. Press vinyl feet into grooves at underside of threshold legs.

- 5. Caulk ends of threshold (important for effective sealing and moisture control).
- 6. Secure threshold to floor with supplied screws. (When fastening to concrete, use anchors; anchors not included.)
